Typical universal lift truck buckets connect to forks which are up to 6" wide and are 48" long. Larger fork pockets can be prearranged via an account manager upon request.

In view of the fact that universal fit forklift buckets slip onto the forks directly, they stay on the machine and are much less at risk to damage. These buckets are also 50 percent deeper than the quick-tach bucket models. This additional space makes them perfect for lifting irregular shaped loads like for example moving large debris piles, broken up concrete, backfilling behind walls, tearing of roof trash and elevating roof gravel.

Moreover, made as attachments for extendable-reach lift trucks, Quick-Tach buckets, are designed to allow the placement of materials way beyond the normal reach of the loader. A hardened beveled cutting blade on both sides and on the leading edge reinforces stability, resistance to wear and tear and provides supreme durability. Quick-Tach lift truck buckets are augmented by scuff bars along the base of the unit which shield it from abrasion.

Quick-Tach lift buckets could in many situations replace the forks and carriage of a forklift, that may weigh anywhere between 100-700lbs. These buckets when installed could free up more load capacity, enabling it to deal with both bigger and heavier materials. The Quick-Tach is able to dump items around 1.5 feet higher thanks to the shorter depth of its bucket.
