To properly and meticulously reconstruct a lift truck engine, a good company will entirely disassemble it. A heat cleaning system can then be used to clean all the parts. When this step has been completed, all of the parts are checked to see if they have any extensive wear, any defects or breakage. Specific components like for example cylinder heads, crankshafts, cylinder blocks and connecting rods are resurfaced, resized and reground if considered necessary. Various components such as bolts, gears, nuts etc. are replaced or repaired as needed.

Once the overhaul has been done, the engine is rebuilt manually. After being reassembled, a series of tests are applied to the running equipment to be able to check all of the parts and make certain there are no leaks or issues. If any problems occur, the necessary adjustments are done.
